## 2324/18 Approval of Minutes

**Resolved:** that the minutes of the meeting held on the 17<sup>th</sup> October 2023 are approved as a correct record. (Cllr. Leggett abstained as he had not been present at the meeting.)

#### 2324/19 Bank reconciliation
