### Grass Cutting 2025 - 2028 - Schedule One

**SCOPE:** Two Grass Cutting Tasks

Task A Glasshouses Village Green (<https://w3w.co/toads.picked.finest>)

Task B Glasshouses Play Field (<https://w3w.co/backpacks.highways.back>)

#### SPECIFICATION:

<b>1</b>	<b>Frequency</b> 14 cuts in all, the first being in early/mid April, and the second before the May Day Bank Holiday Monday. Thereafter at approximately two weekly intervals until the end of October. If the grass is growing fast or slow, cuts may be varied, as long as the Green and the Play Area are kept short and tidy. If in doubt, consult the Clerk or lead Councillor.
<b>2</b>	<b>Strimming</b> The Contractor is to strim round all seats, poles and other obstructions, and trim the edges of the Village Green.
<b>3</b>	<b>Clippings/Litter</b> The Contractor is to sweep up any clippings which stray onto roads and paths. Otherwise clippings are to be left in situ. Any litter is to be removed.
<b>4</b>	<b>Bulbs</b> The Contractor is to cut around bulbs, and to leave bulb growth until the foliage has died back before cutting – usually mid to late June.
<b>5</b>	<b>Moles</b> The Town Council will endeavour to control moles, but where any mole hills exist, these should be spread out before cutting.
<b>6</b>	<b>Well Head</b> The Well Head on the Village Green is to be cleaned out.

## Grass Cutting/Strimming Tasks 2025 - 2028 - Schedule Two

### TASKS:

<b>A</b>	<b>Triangle opposite the Pinfold</b> Cut/strim approx 70 yards <b>just beyond the 40 mph sign</b> by 15 yards on the Pateley side of the road to Blue Plain, covering both sides of the footpath. Leave brambles in situ to about one yard's depth from the wall.
<b>B</b>	<b>Glasshouses Sign on B6165</b> Cut/strim from ten yards beyond the stone village sign on the Harrogate side, and back towards Glasshouses to the edge of the lay-by, and cut/strim the border behind the lay-by and the verge to the junction.
<b>C</b>	<b>The Pinfold</b> The Pinfold is the triangular plot of grass on the corner of the Glasshouses main village street and the B6165, extending on the Pateley side to <b>just beyond the 40 mph sign</b> .
<b>D</b>	<b>Glasshouses</b> Grassed area at the corner of the village lane and Harewell Close.
<b>E</b>	<b>Pateley Bridge Town Sign on B6165</b> Cut/strim, from four yards beyond the sign on the Pateley side, for about seven yards to the seat and about four yards beyond it, to a depth of approx four yards.
<b>F</b>	<b>Pateley Bridge</b> Two stretches of grass verge either side of the junction with Panorama Way on the B6165, extending some 40 yards in both directions; plus under the High Wall up Panorama Way for about 25 yards.
<b>G</b>	<b>Play Field</b> Strim round all trees and all other areas not cut under Schedule One.
<b>H</b>	<b>Junction of Springfield Way and Springfield Close</b> Small area of grass cutting.

### SPECIFICATION:

<b>1</b>	<b>Frequency</b> All Tasks A – H. Six times from mid April, then each month to September.
<b>2</b>	<b>Extent</b> The Contractor should strim and remove tufts under and around seats, signs and other obstructions.

<b>3</b>	<b>Bulbs</b> The Contractor should cut around any bulbs and leave foliage until it has died back – usually mid to late June.
<b>4</b>	<b>Clippings/Litter</b> The Contractor is to sweep up any clippings which stray onto roads and paths. Any litter is to be removed.
<b>5</b>	<b>Trees</b> Damage to trees should be avoided by leaving a one-foot clearance around tree trunks.
