The closing date for applications is Tues 30 June 2020

To qualify to become a Parish Councillor a person must be a British citizen, an eligible Commonwealth citizen, or a citizen of any member state of the EU, and be over 18 years old. In addition you must meet at least one of the following: 1) be listed on the current electoral role; 2) live in the Parish of High and Low Bishopside or within three miles of its boundary 3) occupy as owner/tenant any land/premises therein or 4) have a principal place of work within the Parish. You must not be disqualified from holding office as a Councillor.
