#### 4. Bins in the Recreation Ground

The decision to keep the 3 bins in the Recreation Ground for the convenience of the public had unfortunately become problematic. They overflowed frequently and needed emptying daily in good weather, which was proving expensive. Members felt it would be better for park users to use the large bins at the edge of the park. *Resolved:* 

- i. that the bins in the Recreation Ground are removed with immediate effect
- ii. that the removed bins are kept for possible re-deployment in the parishes.

#### 5. Vandalism at the Recreation Ground

The PBTC had provided Members with a list of vandalism in and around Pateley Bridge, which showed that there were significant issues.

Members felt that such vandalism came and went in phases.

Unfortunately, a representative from the Police had not been able to attend. They had however advised against CCTV because of the regulation around it.

Members discussed the possibility of dummy CCTV.

It was agreed that Cllr. Andrew Murday would speak to the Police about an increased police presence and the possibility of a temporary camera.

It was further agreed that Cllr. Andrew Murday would look into the possibility of NYC funding wrought iron barriers to protect the public conveniences.

**Resolved:** that the Clerk puts details on social media about the vandalism, inviting members of the public to contact the clerk or Police if they have any further information.
